**DIVERSION OF VEHICULAR TRAFFIC
Great Haywood Road
Tixall**

NOTICE is hereby given that the Staffordshire County Council on 10th November 2020 made an Order the effect of which will be to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding in that length of Great Haywood Road in Tixall, from its junction with its access road leading to the property named 'The Old Rectory' and continuing for a distance of approximately 50 metres in a generally south-westerly direction, unless the vehicle is being used in connection with the works, or unless the vehicle requires access to premises on the length of road or is being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.

The order will come into operation on 16th November 2020 and the said works (which will take place between the hours of 08:00 and 16:30) will commence on or as near as practicable to that date. It is anticipated that the works will be completed on the same day.

The Order will remain in force for a period of 18 months, or until the BT pole replacement works, which it is proposed to carry out on or near the road have been completed, whichever is the earlier.
