**TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC  
HOLDIFORD ROAD, TIXALL**

**NOTICE** is hereby given that the Staffordshire County Council on 27 September 2022 made an Order the effect of which will be to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding in that length of Holdiford Road in Tixall from the fork of Holdiford Road near Milford Pumping Station to a point approximately 70 metres north of the Staffordshire and Worcestershire Canal and Tixall Bridge unless the vehicle is being used in connection with the works. Access for pedestrians and cyclists will be available.

An alternative route for traffic is available via A513 Main Road, A513 Milford Road, A513 Weeping Cross, A34 Radford Bank, A34 Queensville, A34 Queensville Roundabout, A34 Queensville Bridge, A34 Lichfield Road, A34 Queensway, A518 Lammascote Road, A518 Weston Road, Blackheath Lane, Tixall Road and vice versa. **The order will come into operation on 3 October 2022 and the said works will commence on or as near as practicable to that date. It is anticipated that the works will be completed by 28 October 2022.**

The Order will remain in force for a period of 18 months, or until the Staffordshire County Council works to signalise Holdiford Bridge and Tixall Bridge with two sets of signal heads on each approach, which it is proposed to carry out on or near the road have been completed, whichever is the earlier.
